Images is now accepting Curatorial Proposals for the 31st annual Images Festival taking place April 12 – 20, 2018 in Toronto, Canada.

We are accepting proposals for in cinema Screenings, Gallery Exhibitions, and Live Performances. Please note that this call is for Curators, Programmers and Researchers only. **If you are an individual artist, please do not apply through this stream.**

Images Festival will cover artists' fees according to the 2017/18 IMAA fee schedule and offer a modest programmer's honorarium, if your proposal is selected. Guest Programmers will collaborate with our Artistic Director and programming staff to realize the program, including assistance with print traffic, marketing, and details associated with presentation of the work(s).

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY. INCOMPLETE PROPOSALS WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR CONSIDERATION.

To submit screening proposals for review, please include the following material including links and your CV into one PDF:

- Title of your program
- Full program notes including artist names, run times, year, and formats. (Preview links are strongly encouraged, or past examples if the works are new)
- Overall run time (Run times around 60 minutes or less are

preferable)

If you are submitting a guest curatorial proposal for gallery exhibition/live performance, please also include in addition to the above list:

- GTA gallery/venue preferences (top 3) or minimum square foot requirements
- Short curatorial statement (100 – 300 words)
- Technical rider
